Gift Cards where a % goes to Education Dollars for stores you already shop.

PAY IN FULL

You are always welcome to just pay off your education dollars at any point during the year.

You should receive statements throughout the year to let you know where you are at with your Education Dollar balance. At the end of the year, if you have not met the Education Dollar requirement, you will receive a final statement from St. Alberts that requires payment before report cards will be released.
