

A Note from Miss Sears

Happy Catholic Schools Week! This week we will learn about the history of Catholic schools and what different Catholic schools look like across the country. We will make cards and send them to other Catholic schools in the country. We will have a religion test next Tuesday on Chapters 9 and 10. Students may use their books.

Holes book reports are due next **Wednesday, January 29th**. Apologies for my mistake on the date on last week's newsletter.

Reading Counts points are due this Friday, January 31st! Students must have a total of 20 points, 5 of which need to be non-fiction. This is a busy week full of activities. I recommend that students do not wait until Friday to take their last test. *Holes* and reading group books **do not** count for reading counts points.

We are continuing units of measurement in math. I highly recommend students use IXL to continue their learning. I will begin requiring a minimum amount of time on IXL for each week (Friday-Friday) starting in the third quarter, which begins next week. Unit 4 test corrections are due Friday.

In science the students will work on their poster advertisement for the rock they researched last week. Today Mr. Mac came for our last edible rock lesson. We learned about metamorphic rocks. Tomorrow we will see what the rocks are like!

In social studies we are continuing to learn about the Donner Party. This party is particularly relevant to us in Northern Nevada. The students will learn what it was like during the winter when they traveled and draw on what they know about winters here to make inferences about what they experienced. Our next unit will cover what Nevada was like when it was first settled.
