

Our first writing project is due tomorrow, October 17th. If you have printing difficulties, I am happy to print your child's project at school, just email it to me.

Multiplying multidigit numbers can be tricky! Please feel free to use IXL each night to help reinforce this skill. It is essential that the students understand what we are doing now for later lessons. I am reviewing as much as possible during the day, but IXL is a great (and fun!) resource to use to help with that. We will have a couple graded math pages in the next couple of weeks, so please encourage your child to practice multi-digit multiplication.

We will have our first science project starting this week. The students will be using what they know about energy and creating a solar cooker. Please look for a guidelines sheet coming home this week. This includes directions, approved materials, and a grading guide that I will use.

Our Nevada questions start up again this week. Please keep an eye out for clues in your child's planner.
