

## A note from Miss Sears

This week starts Ordinary Time in our church calendar. The students learned about Pentecost today. We will continue with Chapter 19 tomorrow.

Reading Counts Points are due June 5<sup>th</sup>. As always, I recommend the students get them done sooner rather than later, and with this being the end of the fourth quarter there will be no exceptions on this due date. If you notice your child having a difficult time picking or finishing books, please let me know—I am happy to help! Book report books and books read in class as a reading group or whole class do not count for points.

We have started learning how to find common denominators. Please check your child's homework each night to ensure they understand the topic outside of school. Please help your child to remember to use IXL for extra practice. On some of the topics they are looking for fractions reduced to lowest terms. We have started learning this, so I highly recommend your child remember to reduce the fraction if possible. One way to do this is to look for prime and composite numbers in the numerators and denominators.

In social studies we will be working on doing some research for their Chautauqua presentations. They will need to work on it at home as well, but we will get a start on it at school. Your child will also come home with a presentation date this week. This is the day they will need to bring their costume to school. They may not wear it to school in place of their uniform. I will give a specific time for them to change into their costumes. If you have any questions, please let me know.
