What is Angel works?

Angel works is an outreach service to provide comfort to St. Albert the Great School families, friends, and Parish families who are experiencing unexpected challenges in their lives. As the name of this program – Angel -- implies, is to provide comfort when comfort is needed the most.

What types of services does Angel works provide?

The services depend on the specific needs of the family. For example, if a family member is hospitalized and their meal preparation has been impacted by hospital visits, home-cooked dinners may be sought.

Similarly, if a parent has lost employment, there may be a need for monetary assistance. For example, the assistance may be in the form of gift cards to local grocery stores.

How do I deliver donations?

Donations to the Angel works fund can be delivered to the St. Albert School office. The Angel works coordinator(s) will then see that the intended family receives the support.

Will the identity of the receiving family be known?

No. The confidentiality of the receiving family will be maintained.

Will the receiving family be notified of the donor’s identity?

No. The confidentiality of the donors will be maintained.
