
Dear St. Albert's Families,

I am forwarding the most recent letter from the Diocese of Reno confirming Governor Sisolak's decision to cancel all K-12 schools in the State of Nevada for the next three weeks. I hope that everyone has received a copy of their assignments for this week, and that students are already starting to get a head start on the work. There will not be any assignments during Spring Break; however, there will be another week's worth of assignments emailed home to parents by March 30<sup>th</sup>. We are hoping that school will resume on April 6<sup>th</sup>, and all assignments will be due on that date. In the event that schools are cancelled past that date, we will continue to email assignments home and include the use of Zoom, YouTube videos, and other online resources that will help supplement your child's education. Teachers will be available to answer your questions via email from 8:00-3:00 on school days, but they will not be available during Spring Break.

Thank you to everyone who stopped in at 10:00 today to pick up their child's work due to absences on Friday. Thank goodness we were proactive by having the students take home all of their books and supplies so that they can continue learning while school is closed. Registration paperwork and deposits will not be due until school reopens, hopefully on April 6<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Bob and Jimmy are working hard to completely deep clean our school from top to bottom to make sure that it is clean and safe for students, faculty, and staff when we return.

We will continue to keep you updated as things change. We are keeping you in our prayers and hope that everyone continues to stay safe and healthy. Please continue to pray for everyone who has been impacted by the Coronavirus.
